

Synopsis

A short poetic, personal documentary.

Born in Sydney and taken away at five by her parents to live in their original homeland, Greece, she only comes to Australia when her son wants to study at the University. Back in Sydney, she starts experiencing an increasing familiarity with some surroundings, not sure if that familiarity comes from actual memories she has as a very young child; or her imagination is kicking in colouring things. Tracing those "memories," she reaches a point where past, present and future fuse into a unique perception and understanding, making her feel connected once again with this place and through that with her own inner self as a whole.



Belonging & Identity / a director's statement

This is the story of a woman, who, in search of her identity, discovers a whole country, Australia, that she was connected to, since she was born there, but had discarded for a long period of her life, in her struggle to belong only to one place. In her quest to become whole, she has to educate herself about the situations she meets in this new country, raise the veil of denial and embrace her first homeland and, with that, her very young intimate self.

In return, she receives answers to questions that have been troubling her for decades in her adult life, like why, for instance, she always felt a stranger within her own family.

Why did I make this documentary:

This documentary serves me as a visual notebook, marking possible traces of my existence here in the past and connecting to myself as I am nowadays.

What effect am I trying to have on audience?

I am convinced, that an audience likes to lean on somebody else's story first and through that draw the courage to address their own issues of belonging and identity, which could have similarities to my story or differences (that is of secondary importance).

What do I want the documentary to do? (resonance and theme)

I want it to encourage people to delve into their own story, choosing details from my own journey, which resonate with them and speak to their soul.

And finally,I believe this documentary has the potential to inspire people, even if they don't identify with my particular story, because themes like belonging and identity, are much bigger than me and everyone of us, individually.





where she finds herself behind and infront of the camera.



Final Comments

It is not easy to tackle all issues of such an enterprise with the same effectiveness, but looking back, I see how the impossible becomes doable. I think that the basic elements for such a documentary, performative by nature, have been implemented efficiently, only to reveal of course the next levels of perfection, waiting to be conquered in a future project.

Being by myself in creating this film has its pluses and minuses. I am able to work on my own rhythm, allowing my concentration to heighten uninterrupted. That has as a result to be able to clarify the subject of the film (what I want to say), as well as define my own unique ways of how to say that (sharpen my expressive audiovisual tools to effectively express what I mean).

In the short while that this film has to be delivered, there is not enough time to cover unknown areas, all by myself, and produce a good result, so the quality of the outcome in those issues might suffer at points or as a whole. However, at this point I believe I am ready to hold an acceptable standard in all areas, with a lot to look still ahead. For example, although I know quite a few things about color grading in Premiere Pro, I see two roads opening ahead and asking for my engagement. One is keep adding to my Premiere Pro tools until it is exhausted, which hasn't happened yet, and two, learn the process of shifting to Da Vinci Resolve for that final outcome, which I am still experimenting on.

"Ultimately, I did learn a great deal from my time working on this creative thesis. I was once again reminded that success rarely comes in the first attempt.
